

Uni project

CYPRUS has secured its first major EU-funded programme in the area of archeology and arch-eometry, the University of Cyprus said yesterday. The programme is expected to draw international attention and put Cyprus at the centre of world archeology studies.

The programme will be coordinated by the Archaeological Research Unit of the university, starting from December 1 and aims at training researchers in the study of ancient materials.

Moreover, twenty new posts are expected to be filled, mostly by young researchers, to staff the programme, which will run for four years at a cost of €4.6 million.
